$$A = \begin{pmatrix} 4 & 2 & 2 \\ 2 & 0 & 1 \\ 2 & 1 & 1 \end{pmatrix}.$$

- (ii) A linear transformation $T: \mathbb{R}^3 \rightarrow \mathbb{R}^2$ is defined by

$$T(x, y, z) = (3x - 2y + z, x - 3y - 2z), (x, y, z) \in \mathbb{R}^3$$

Find the matrix of T relative to the ordered bases of $(1,0,0)$, $(0,1,0)$, $(0,0,1)$ of \mathbb{R}^3 and $(1,0)$, $(0,1)$ of \mathbb{R}^2 .
