

- *23rd April 1858- 5th April 1922
- Social Reformer, Pioneer in Education and Emancipator of women
- First woman to be given the title of Pandita as a Sanskrit Scholar and Sarasvati after being examined by the faculty of University of Calcutta
- One of the 10 women delegates of the Congress session of 1989
- Keshab Chandra Sen gave her a copy of the Vedas to read
