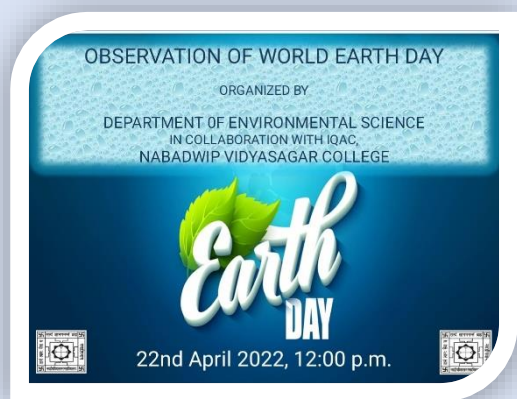
“VASANTA UTSAV” – The Festival of Spring celebrations

100 years Celebration of BIDROHI KABITA

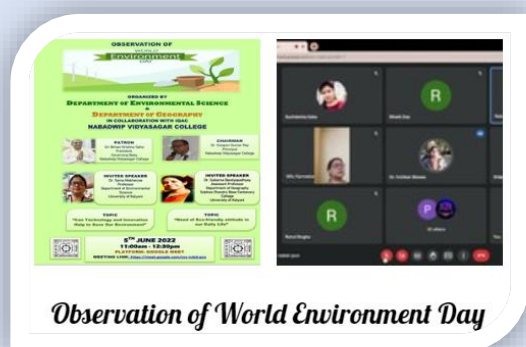

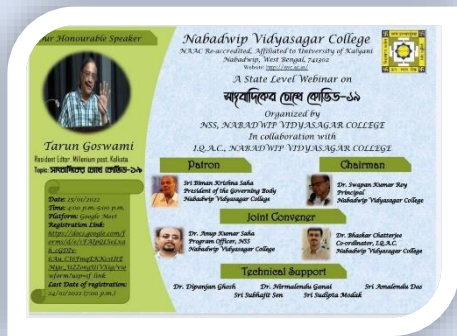

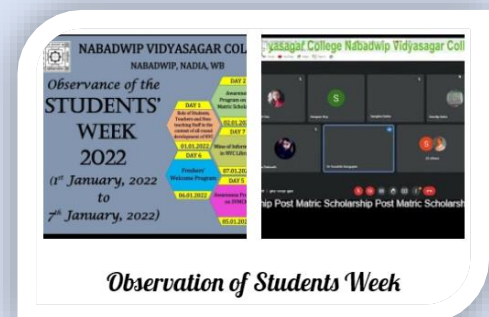
A State Level WEBINAR on “Sangbadiker Choke Covid – 19”

IRINS is web-based Research Information Management (RIM) service developed by the Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET) Centre. The portal facilitates the academic, R&D organizations and faculty members, scientists to collect, curate and

showcase the scholarly communication activities and provide an opportunity to create the scholarly network. The IRINS is available as free software-as-service to the academic and R&D organizations in India.



The IRINS would support to integrate the existing research management system such as

HR system, course management, grant management system, institutional repository, open and commercial citation databases,

scholarly publishers, etc. It has integrated with academic identity such as ORCID ID, ScopusID, Research ID, Microsoft Academic ID, Google Scholar ID for ingesting the scholarly publication from various sources.



Benefits of the stockholders:

- ✓ It provides immense support to find mentors or advisors for their research in the respective domain;
- ✓ It helps the scholars to locate courses in their subject interests and research focus of the department and organization; and
- ✓ It provides scholarly metadata related to research interests of faculty members, research focus of the departments and schools.

- ✓ It provides more significant exposure for their research contributions to the international community and brings funding opportunities from the national and international agencies; and

Once they log in the 'Admin Expert View' dashboard page will be displayed. From here they can view the existing and current number of profiles which were mapped with the institute IRINS. On the dashboard, the Nodal officer can view various tab's having different functionalities such as Update publication & citation from SCOPUS; Update citation from SCOPUS; SOLR Indexing; Export; Add Expert; Active; Reject; Hold; Send Email etc.,. The Nodal officer can make use of the above mentioned tabs to closely monitor the institute IRINS functionality.

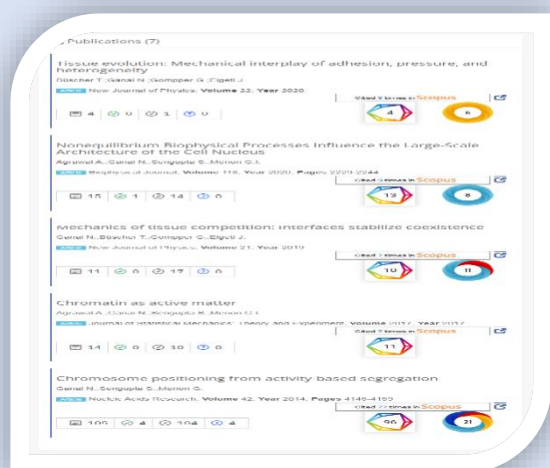
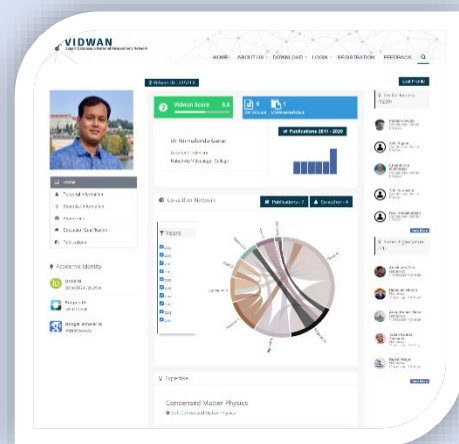
