He described the virus minutely and illustrated the current scenario of the disease in the World as well as in India with statistics. He pointed toward the precautions to stop its spreading and finally he finished his lecture by showing how one can model the spreading of the virus mathematically to predict the cases in the future.

The Navya-Nyāya or New-logical Darsana of Indian logic and Indian philosophy was founded in the 13th century CE by the philosopher Ganges Upādhyāya Mithila and continued by Raghunath Shiromani of Nabadwip in Bengal. It was a development of the classical Nyāya Darsāna. Navya-Nyāya developed a sophisticated language and conceptual scheme that allowed it to raise, analyze and solve problems in logic and epistemology. It systematized all the Nyāya concepts into four main categories which are perception (Pratyaksha), inference (anumāna) , comparison or similarity (upamāna), and testimony (sound or word; sābda). Pratyaksha (Sanskrit :"that which is before one's eyes) in Indian Philosophy, perception, the first of the four means of knowledge, or pramanas , that enable a person to have correct cognitions of the world. Pratyaksha is of two kinds, direct perception (Anubhava) and remembered perception (Smriti). Some schools make a further distinction between indiscriminate perception (Nirvikalpaka), in which the distinguishing features are both observed and recognised. Indiscriminate followers of the Advaita (Nondualist) school of Vedanta, for it allows for the liberating perception. And finally ends with a vote of thanks.
